
The Super Bouv Series was published in December 2013 by Partners Publishing LLC. The series was created by Lee Ann Billings, who has a BA in Journalism. She based the main character, Ruby, on her own Bouvier. After years of observing the antics and talents of her real-life Ruby, she had no shortage of story ideas for the books. In fact, some of the stories in the books are true stories about the dog! For example, at the end of book three Ruby becomes a service dog, much the same as Lee Ann's Bouv has become for her family. Billings points out, "The project was a labor of love... a way for me to honor my own Bouvier, who has brought so much into our family, while sharing stories about the uniqueness of the Bouvier des Flandres breed." Indeed, the story behind the story is a fascinating one; I hope it will appear in the Summer RESCUE ROUNDUP.

The titles of the three books in the series are: *Ruby and Her New Family, Ruby and Her New Home*, and *Ruby and Her New Job*. As the series unfolds, Ruby grows from a puppy and eventually ventures forth


Visceglia shares, "I thought they were

into the world to bravely find a new family, a new home, and a new job – but not without some mishaps!


The stories are brought to life by artist Maegan Penley, who has a BFA in Illustration. She used both watercolor and acrylic paints in each scene to create rich artwork that depicts the Bouv intelligence and humor in full action. Penley describes herself as a serious dog lover. She owns both a Boxer and a "Bulldoxer," whom Ruby gets to "meet" when they make a brief cameo in the first book in the series.



In the second book in the series, Ruby bravely ventures off to her new home. As she crosses over the river and travels through the green hills, she has no idea where she is going – or the obstacles she will face. Journey along as Ruby encounters surprises and solves a mystery that will protect her new family.

Richard Adams, a Bouvier owner himself, feels that Billings and Penley have made a great team. After reading the books he said, "Our five-year-old granddaughter loves the books, especially the illustrations. And the storyline is a great lesson for kids to learn." Adams adds, "Kids need to read books and this series will capture their attention!"

As word of the Super Bouv Series has spread, Bouvier lovers from many parts of the world – the United States, Australia, Canada, and the United Kingdom – have enjoyed these delightful books.
